From the purview of the Moderator.....

On January 28th, we meet for our annual Congregational meeting. We have lots on the agenda so we will start promptly after worship because our Food Pantry outreach begins at 1pm with set up the hour before. Additionally, we normally gather after worship bet lynch and social time, and we don't want to also that right?!! Vileage how do we

Last week, Donna Moon's friend Opi who has an Indian Food service business prepared a delicious Indian food meal on Christmas Eve for our Food Pantry Outreach. Opi made plenty food so even the volunteers could enjoy a wonderful meal too. She also came with her own team of helpers who did the plating and serving of the food! Remember my newsletter from the other month about how we were worrying about "burn out" by volunteers? Well, now Opi has offered to cook a meal for the Food Pantry once a month and will start by taking January 28th, the day of our Annual Meeting. More amazing, right?!! There is another wonderful surprise happening in the Food Pantry that will alleviate some time constraints I'm worried about on January 28th, but I can't divulge that information just yet. Stay tuned till the February Newsletter....:) Yes, God is reminding us that if we are faithful and prayerful, God provides resources and inspiration to help us overcome trials and tribulations!

On the meeting agenda is the amendments to the constitution and bylaws. This is one of the things we asked Pastor Rob to help us with when he was hired because our bylaws were written for churches with very large memberships and also, written at a time when members did all the work of operating a church which today, does not happen and social views of the world have evolved. Naomi Hamamura, Richard Stillman and I made up the committee with Pastor Rob. We have presented the changes to the council that raised some really healthy discussion on several items and pushed the committee to meet again in response to it. I will be presenting the 2024 budget. We continue to work towards reducing the operating deficit but unfortunately with rising costs, and we are not able to balance the budget. At the moment, we do not need to draw from investments to cover the shortfall. I've mentioned numerous times at council meetings, the church remains healthy in spite of the shortfall because income AND participation is growing. There is life happening in this church that is not measured in the financial reports. There are new faces amongst the existing faces, lots of laughter and celebrations happening, new energies and resources rising to meet our challenges, and always, lots of love and caring for each other and others that often goes unseen and unpublished. Our goal for 2024 is to obtain our own 501(3)c status instead of sitting under the umbrella of the UCC non-profit status so we can go after grants to help us.

And lastly on the agenda, is our vote to call Pastor Rob as our settled pastor. The past three years of calling a new pastor and working with Pastor Rob has been an amazing and very blessed journey. We have so much to be grateful for thanks to his leadership and the ongoing commitment of all the members and friends who make up this community of faith.

As I look towards 2024, I ask for your continued prayers and support of the ongoing life of Kapaa UCC, to be a light of Gods abiding love to every person and thing on this great earth.


